RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION SCHEDULE KEY FOR 2019:



- **Household Refuse** - will be collected on Mondays in ALL zones. Refuse should be placed at the curb before 6:00AM but not before 6:00PM on Sunday. Bag weight limit remains at 30 pounds, Bag size is 33 gallons.



- **Single Stream Recyclables** will be every other Wednesday.

Acceptable Paper & Comingled Recyclables: All Paper Fiber, Corrugated Cardboard, Newsprint (incl inserts), Magazines/Brochures, Phone Books, Hard/Soft Back Books, Office Paper, File Folders, Computer Paper, Junk Mail * Catalogues, Envelopes, Paper Egg Cartons, Plastic Shopping Bags, Aluminum Cans, Tin Cans, Plastic Beverage Containers, Plastic Detergent/Milk Containers, Glass Bottles, Plastics #1-#7, Pots & Pans.



Restricted Materials: Plate Glass/Ceramics, Non-Recyclable Plastics, Toys, Fence, Coolers, Baskets, Furniture, Electronics, PVC Pipe, Conduit, Needles/Syringes, Food Waste, Trash, Appliances, Wood, Rubber (hoses etc.) Diapers/Bio-Hazardous Waste, Scrap Metal and Styrofoam.



CARDBOARD - MUST BE BROKEN DOWN AND TIED UP.

The Dept of Public Works will not take any container with Restricted Materials.



- **Ashes** will be collected on Thursdays.



- **Yard Waste** collections are every Thursday in April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November. Collections will be picked up once in December. Place it in open containers or paper bags and branches must be bundled to a maximum length of 4 feet.

(YARD WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED IN PLASTIC BAGS)



- **Glossy magazines / corrugated cardboard / phone books** can be dropped off at the DPW building at any time Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:00am to 2:00pm and Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 7:00am to 3:30pm. Cardboard should be flattened and deposited in or next to the Yellow Recycling Truck.

- **White Goods** (washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, mattresses, etc.) are a special fee of \$20.00 per item. The fees for any white good must be paid to the Borough Building business office before the items can be picked up. The pick-up day/time will be given upon payment but is generally within a few days.

You must register with the Borough between January 2, 2019 and April 1, 2019 during normal business hours. If you fail to do so, a citation will be issued immediately. - The fee is \$30.00 per housing unit/apartment if purchased by April 30th.
 - From May 1st to June 30th the fee is \$50.00
 - After June 30th citation and penalties will follow.
