2015 RECYCLING PERFORMANCE GRANT

Attention Business Owners / Authorized Personnel:

In compliance with §1501 (c) (1) (iii) of Act 101 and as a mandated recycling community, §20-201 titled "Mandatory Recycling Law of the Borough of Edwardsville", commercial establishments located in a mandated community are required to recycle <u>at least</u> one item, preferably cardboard or comingled (i.e. glass, plastic, aluminum, or bi-metallic cans) or paper, be it office, newspaper or magazines.

It is very important to commercial establishments to recycle for two very important reasons; by recycling, you can greatly reduce the yearly refuse costs by diverting this material from the landfills. Less materials means less pickups and less pickups means less cost to company. The second is to help and protect our environment.

Attached, I have enclosed a copy of our Mandated Recycling Ordinance along with two forms that <u>MUST</u> be completed by the owner / authorized individual at this business location. These forms must be returned to the Boro <u>no later than February 1, 2016</u>.
